OBITUARY

The family of Sharon E. Cournoyer are deeply saddened to announce her passing on April 11, 2024, in the Victoria General Hospital after a lengthy period of illness.

Born in St. John's, NL, on August 17, 1947, Sharon was the beloved and only child of Harvey Chesley Dawe and Jean Margaret (Cornick) Dawe. Due to her father's employment with the federal government the family later established their permanent residence in Halifax, NS.

Following her graduation from Queen Elizabeth High School Sharon earned a Bachelor of Arts from Dalhousie University with a major in Psychology showcasing her dedication to learning and her understanding of the human mind.

After graduation Sharon was employed as a Vocational Rehabilitation Counsellor at the Rehabilitation Centre located in the old Civic Hospital. While employed with Justice her work had a positive impact on many lives, Sharon received the federal Corrections Exemplary Service Medal and the NS Government's 25-year Long Service Award before her retirement.
